Last Drop Off, May 28th

We will have a last drop off on May 28th. Students in 3k - 2nd grade may have library books, school work, or Chromebooks to drop off. Please drop off between 11-12pm on Thursday, May 28th. Students in grades 3-5, have textbooks, library books, recorders, and possibly Chromebooks. We will be checking these in on Thursday morning between 10-11am. Please form a line starting at the office door and stay in your vehicle. We will come to your vehicle to get the items and check that you turned them in in the condition they went home and that you have returned everything we need. If there is anything you need to pick up, we will bring it out to you. There are TimberRattler tickets that students earned for reading in library to pick up, too. Let us know if this time doesn't work for you, so we can make sure we find a time to get your things next week.
