Sweet Corn

Back in the 1970s my brothers and sisters and I had a goal to sell enough sweet corn to buy a trail motorcycle. Our neighbor, Jerome Kuepper, was our Pioneer seed corn dealer and he helped us figure out how much we would need to plant to reach our goal. We prepared the field and planted the seeds and prayed for the best. We hoed the rows and pulled weeds and finally picked the ripened ears. Dad helped set up our stand at the corner of State Park Road and Highway 114, right by the Shady Rest tavern. Depending on the competition, we could get 60 to 75 cents per dozen. We would also sell some tomatoes, cucumbers and other garden produce, but sweet corn was by far our main source of revenue.

Why am I sharing this story? Well, while farmers and gardeners are praying for favorable weather, Saint Edward staff, finance and pastoral councils and committees are preparing reports to present at the annual meeting. I am grateful for your generosity of time, talent and treasure. I am amazed at your joyful embrace of serving God and neighbor in so many ways. Take a look at page five that shows our parish outreach. Read through the names of those who were baptized, received First Holy Communion, confirmed or married in the last year. Thank God for these blessings. Remember in prayer our departed brothers and sisters.

Read over our financial statement. It shows many sources of revenue, but nothing helps the bottom line more than the top line. That top line, our main source of revenue, is your regular parish support!

How much should we give? Begin by counting your blessings. How about starting with the biblical concept of "first fruits?" For working folks, consider giving weekly an amount equal to the value of the first hour of your work-week. For those working forty hours per week, that would be 2.5% of your earnings. For retirees or those on fixed incomes, try to commit to some regular giving. To simplify life, I use an electronic fund transfer (EFT.)

Back to the sweetcorn story....by the end of the season, we were

ripping through the corn stubble on a Honda Trail 70.
